RESOLUTION NO. 79-329

RESOLUTION FORMING LINNE  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, following submittal of petitions signed by 64% of the registered voters requesting formation of a community services district, the Local Agency Formation Commission of San Luis Obispo County by Resolution No. 79-6, dated June 7, 1979, approved formation of Linne Community Services District subject to the following conditions:

1. That the types of services empowered upon formation are restricted to road maintenance pursuant to Government Code 61600, subsection (j) and fire protection only.

2. That at any future time said District Board desires to expand the District's services it must first obtain approval from the Local Agency Formation Commission and the County Board of Supervisors.

3. That boundaries be established as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

4. That if at the hearing before the Board of Supervisors, a petition is filed signed by at least 80% of the registered voters within said proposed district requesting and favoring formation of the district, no election be required pursuant to Government Code Section 61114.

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and economically feasible that said Community Services District be formed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

1. That it be and hereby is determined and found that the petitions and all other proceedings in regard to establishment of Linne Community Services District were valid and in complete conformity and compliance with requirements of both Sections 54773 et. seq. and Sections 61000 et. seq. of the Government Code; and that the petitions and notice are genuine and sufficient.

2. That it be and hereby is found that recitals set out herein are true and correct.

3. That it be and hereby is found and determined that petitions have been duly filed signed by at least 80% of the registered voters within the proposed district requesting and favoring formation of said district, and no written or oral protests have been received or offered at the hearing or hearings.

4. That pursuant to Government Code Section 61114, no election is required on the question of the formation of said district.

5. That it be and hereby is declared and determined and ordered that Linne Community Services District be and hereby is duly organized, established and formed in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, with the District's boundaries fixed as particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as though here fully set forth.

6. That it be and hereby is declared and designated that the types of services to be provided in Linne Community Services District are:

a. Fire protection services, and

b. Road opening, widening, extending, straightening and surfacing, in whole or part of any street in such district, subject to the consent of the governing body of the County.

7. That the County Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Executive Officer of Local Agency Formation Commission as soon as possible.

8. That pursuant to Government Code Section 61114, this Board of Supervisors designated the following persons as members of the first Board of Directors:


